The Court having examined the account of John Harris Deputy Gaoler in the County of Cumberland, for the support of prisoners, on oath exhibited, committed by due process of law upon charges and convictions of crimes against the State confined from June 4th to Dec^r 17. 1833. amounts to the sum of \$289.42. and that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof; said sum has been allowed, and ordered by the Court to be paid out of the County Treasury, and charged to the State, agreeably to Law.
