Having been left here from an attack of severe illness, during the passage of my (2 Maine) Regiment thro' this city, on its way to Washington, and having now entirely recovered, & feeling exceedingly anxious to rejoin my Regiment, I take the liberty of asking that you will take the very earliest measures to forward me to my proper destination. Upon application here, I find that is no authority to grant me a pass ~~from~~ ^{the} by any authorities ~~in~~ this city - hence this letter.
