A REPUBLICAN STATE CONVENTION

will be held in NOROMBEGA HALL, Bangor, Thursday, April 26, 1888, at 11 o'clock a.m.

For the purpose of selecting two candidates for Electors of President and Vice President of the United States, and four delegates at large, and four alternates to attend the National Convention to be held at Chicago, Illinois on Tuesday, June 18, 1888, and transacting any other business that may properly come before it.

The back of representation will be as follows: Each city, town and plantation will be entitled to one delegate, and for each seventy-five votes of the Republican candidate for Governor in 1884, an additional delegate, and for a fraction of forty votes in excess of seventy-five votes, an additional delegate.

The State Committee will be in session in the reception room of the Hall at nine o'clock on the morning of the convention for the purpose of receiving the credentials of delegates.

Electors of Maine, without regard to past political differences, and in sympathy with the sentiments expressed in the call of the Republican National Committee for the Republican National Convention, are cordially invited to unite with the Republicans of the State in electing delegates to this Convention.

The supply of base ball players in the West is reported to be far in excess of the demand. This seems to be a case where a trust cannot be worked to advantage to limit supply.

Senator Brown, of Georgia, is not in favor of dropping the tariff "which has enriched the North" just at the time when the South is beginning to profit by it. Several other Southern politicians think as Senator Brown does, but the lines of party are a little too strong for them to break. But a few more from the South and a few more from the North in Congress may have a wonderful effect on the antiquity party.

Major Hewitt may be credited with sincerity when he says that he is not ambitious for public office. But his dyspepsia may supply the place of ambition. Since his refusal to allow the Irish faction of the City Hall on St. Patrick's day, the fact that these people and associations to whom he has been refusing favors are hounding him unmercifully, seems to have become impressed upon his mind, with more than usual force, and he declares that if this sort of annoyance is kept up he may run again for the office he now holds. He does not feel ambitious, but very ugly.

The bill to consolidate the Boston & Maine and Eastern railroads is before the Massachusetts Legislature. Last year a bill allowing such a consolidation was passed by the Maine Legislature, but was vetoed in Massachusetts. The bill now up for consideration was reported by the railroad committee with but one dissenting voice. Mr. Wyman of Hyde Park, would have the bill provide not only for the consolidation of the two roads, but for an appraisal of the properties, at which appraisal the Commonwealth of Massachusetts might at any time buy up the properties, and for the purpose of fares and freight tolls to correspond with the ability of the road to make such reductions.

The House has passed Mr. Dingler's bill for the issue of fractional currency by a large majority, and favorable action may be expected in the Senate. The bill provides for the issue of silver certificates of the denominations of 10, 15, and 25 cents, to be issued, paid and secured in the same manner as the \$1 and \$2 certificates. The argument that convinced the House of the wisdom of the bill was the great inconvenience in transmitting small sums of money which the people are now under. The sharp edges of silver coin are liable to cut through envelopes, and if postage stamps are used they are liable to stick together and many of them are destroyed in trying to separate them.

Whether Massachusetts will ever see the Legislature of the Day State. From present progress towards the change it may be inferred that the old Massachusetts Legislature was right when he declared to the patriots assembled in Philadelphia to frame the constitution: "The people of Massachusetts will never give up annual elections." At any rate Massachusetts has held her annual elections until she is almost alone in preserving the old usage. With Rhode Island she has clung to the old custom, while all the other New England States have joined the States of the West and South in relieving themselves of the almost continual political turmoil incident to an election every year.

The Boston Globe's knowledge of Maine politics must be obtained by long distance telephone, when the Globe's speech is transmitted very indistinctly. Yesterday it announced that the most prominent candidate for the Republican nomination for governor was the Hon. E. C. Burleigh, with the Hon. Fred Atwood as a good second. It is true that Mr. Burleigh is a candidate though no more prominent than the Hon. H. B. Claves and Gov. Marble, but the Hon. Fred Atwood is not a good second, nor a good third. Indeed he is not a candidate at all and never has been. Funnier than this is the Globe's enumeration of possible candidates in which it names of Governor Neal Dow. The Globe's memory is bad. It is the Democrats with whom the General is affiliating this year and not the Republicans. Possibly he may have been enraged by his success in capturing the Democratic nomination for Mayor of Portland to attempt the bigger feat of capturing the Democratic State Convention, but we don't think he has any designs on the Republican convention.

The Drawbaugh telephone people are by no means discouraged at the decision of the Supreme Court. They point out that three of the four judges who sat on the case—and the three most thoroughly versed in patent law—declared that Drawbaugh was the original inventor of the instrument which Bell patented. It would be possible for the full bench to reverse the present decision, for four is not a majority of nine. There is no doubt that the Drawbaugh claim was by far the most serious one that Bell had to meet. A score of persons testified that they had talked over an apparatus constructed by Drawbaugh long before Bell filed his claim to the patent, and this testimony made so much impression on Justices Field, Harlan and Bradley, that they declared in their dissenting opinion that Drawbaugh's claim was to be the original inventor is sustained by overwhelming evidence. The majority of the court, however, while admitting the force of the testimony, believed that it was more than offset by the fact that Drawbaugh never sought to patent his invention which they believe he could not have failed to do if he had really produced what it is now contended he did. To this the minority reply that Drawbaugh was poor, and not being a man of science and broad education, he did not realize the importance of his invention. Apparently the claims of all the alleged telephone inventors except Drawbaugh are rejected by the whole court, as well as the allegation that an examiner allowed Bell to see Fred Gray's patent, and to change his own specifications after he had deposited them in the patent office. The litigation in these cases has been exceedingly expensive, and the leading patent lawyers in the country have been employed on one side or the other. The Drawbaugh people spent \$100,000 and the Bell people as much in fighting them.

The Hon. Simon S. Brown, chairman of the Democratic State Committee, has at last won a victory. He has got himself elected a member of the board of aldermen of the "virgin city of Waterville" as he styles it, and succeeded in electing the Hon. Reuben Foster, who has heretofore been a Republican, mayor. Naturally Mr. Brown was happy when the vote was counted and promptly notified the New York World, and through

the World, the country of his joy. With extraordinary modesty he gave the credit of the victory to Cleveland's tariff reform message, strategy neglecting the opportunity to claim it as a vindication of his own conduct in the count and in the disposal of Maine post offices, which it was, quite as much as a favorable response to Cleveland's message. Mr. Brown will be virtual mayor for a year to come and will no doubt undertake to perpetuate the power of his party by so gerrymandering the city that a majority of the wards shall be Democratic. This will not be an easy task, but Mr. Brown has once reversed a state election and counted out a Republican legislature. He is a gentleman of great experience in cloak and politics. With Chairman Brown running the political part of the city government assisted by the Hon. Benjamin Barker, it will be much less than the vote of the Under Secretary of the State's first investment as a municipal corporation.

The Anti-Saloon Movement.

The Anti-Saloon movement within the Republican party of the nation was organized at the meeting of the Chicago conference on September 16, 1886. Since that time events which have occurred, especially the late elections in Pennsylvania, Ohio and New York, which have been held in the city of Chicago, had been demonstrated at that time that the true course of the Republican party of the nation is a firm and steady movement against the influence of the saloons, conducted in the most respectable manner. The ground which the Chicago conference adopted the Republican party to take is thus summarized: The saloon is the enemy of society, and ought to be suppressed; the people of each State and municipality ought to have the opportunity, whenever desired, of deciding when and how this shall be done; until destroyed, the saloon ought to be crippled by every restraint and disability which law and public sentiment will enforce, and made to reimburse as much as possible of the public loss it causes. The national committee selected by that conference, on which Senator William P. Frye represents Maine, have now issued the call for the second conference to meet in New York City on the 18th of next April. The platform of the convention of 1886 said nothing about the insertion of an anti-saloon plank in the national platform of the Republican party. The call which has been issued for the second conference sets forth as the special object of the meeting such action as will "assure and signalize the complete withdrawal of the National Republican party from all complicity with the saloon industry," by the adoption of an anti-saloon plank in Chicago. "We believe," says the committee in that call, "there will no longer be the spectacle of a political party, which stands for all that is best in the political life of our people, ignoring in its annual elections a political conflict which annually stirs every community to its depths, which dwells every other issue, and the result of which involves the future of human society on this continent." The deliberations of the conference of next month ought to be well attended and well needed. In every State where it is at all influential in the conduct of affairs, the Republican party has taken a stand against the saloon. There is no good reason why the National platform should be silent on a subject that is today so deeply stirring the rank and file of the party.
