NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS

M. R. S. Title 36 Section 706

Before making an assessment, the assessors shall give reasonable notice in writing to the inhabitants by posting notifications in some public place in the town, or shall notify them, in such other way as the town directs, to make and bring in to them true and perfect lists of their polls and all of their estates, real and personal, not by law exempt from taxation, of which they were possessed on the 1st day of April of the same year. If any resident owner, after such notice, or any non-resident owner after being reasonably requested thereto by the assessors, does not bring in such list, he is thereby barred of his right to make application to the assessors or the county commissioners for any abatement of his taxes, unless he offers such list with his application and satisfies them that he was unable to offer it at the time appointed. The request upon non-resident owners may be proved by a notice sent by mail directed to the last known address of the taxpayer or given by any other method that brings notice home to the taxpayer.

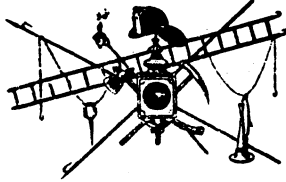

Annual Report of Public Health Nursing Services in
Westport for the year 1970

Public health nursing in the Town of Westport was offered by a member of the staff of the Division of Public Health Nursing. Your nurse provided nursing care, health counseling, and served families through planning to meet health needs. The nursing activities included participation in your school health program and management of child health conferences. The nursing care emphasis was placed on prevention of disease, promotion of health and rehabilitation.

Immunizations and medical appraisal were offered to all pre-school children at Wiscasset child health conferences. Parents were notified of their child's needs for immunization according to their health records and these were given in conjunction with the Wiscasset school health program. Home visits consisted of maternal health, infant and pre-school supervision, and where there have been special health needs known to the nurse. During the eight visits to the town ten persons were visited.

Sincere appreciation is extended to those persons who volunteered time and service to help during the health activities. The cooperation of town officers, is acknowledged.

CONSERVATION COMMISSION ANNUAL REPORT 1970-1971

1. Assisted in the junk-car removal project on Westport (July, 1970).
2. Conducted a public conservation meeting to inform citizens of the function and aims of the Conservation Commission; to hear recommendations from the residents on conservation issues; presented a slide show on Environmental Responsibility, followed by a question-answer period, led by Marshall Burk, Executive Sec., Natural Resources Council of Maine. (August, 1970)
3. Sponsored a successful commission fund-raising folk sing featuring Frank Warner, American folklorist. (August, 1970)
4. Sponsored a roadside clean-up project in which both children and grown-ups enthusiastically participated; resolved to make it a bi-annual occasion. (September, 1970)
5. a) Conducted a study of the present and alternate dump sites; received analysis and interpretation from a soil scientist of the State Soil and Water Conservation Department.
b) Conducted a clean-up project at the present dump site--involving new fill, fencing, and sign.
6. Joined Maine State Conservation Commission Association and attended the November 1970 organ-

izational meeting at Bowdoin College--for the purpose of participating in regional conservation efforts.

7. Conducted a study of the closing of the flats (Back River and Montsweag Bay) to the taking of shell fish; communicated with representatives from the Department of Sea and shore fisheries, Maine Environmental Improvement Commission, Maine Yankee Environmental Studies Department, and Westport residents directly affected by the polluted waters of the Back River.
8. Attended the conference on Solid Waste Disposal and Air Pollution, sponsored by Maine Tuberculosis and Health Assoc. (November, 1970)
9. Became sponsoring member of the Natural Resources Council of Maine--making Westport's Conservation Commission the first commission to be a member of the NRC Board of Directors. (January, 1971)

IN-PROGRESS ACTIVITIES 1971

1. Conducting a study of Westport open space: wilderness area, possible recreation area, wetlands, tidal marshes (Land indexing as required of Conservation Commission by state law.)
2. Studying the means of acquiring land for conservation purposes, public access to the water etc--through conservation easements, land gifts, etc.
3. Applying for matching Federal funds for the acquisition of land at the North end for a recreation area for the town; sponsored joint meetings:

Conservation Commission, Westport selectmen,
and State Park and Recreation Commission.

4. Studying the proposed Wiscasset by-pass on the North end of Westport; encouraging Westport involvement in future state highway planning which affects the island: sponsored joint meeting: Conservation Commission, Westport selectmen, and state Highway Planning Officer, Roger Mallar. (January 12, 1971)
5. Continuing town dump clean-up project: planting of new trees, shrubs, vines--Spring 1971.
6. Studying current and/or pending Federal and state environmental legislation.

The Conservation Commission deeply appreciates the support which the selectmen and all residents are giving to conservation efforts on Westport.

The examination was made in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards and accordingly included such tests of the accounting records and such other auditing procedures as were considered necessary in the circumstances.

In our opinion, the exhibits and schedules incorporated in this report, present fairly the financial position of the Town at February 14, 1970, and the results of its operations for the period indicated.

C O M M E N T S

SCOPE OF AUDIT

The system of internal control was reviewed as pertained to the handling of cash and other matters of financial concern. Count of cash was made and records checked to determine the accuracy of recorded transactions.

An analysis was made of receipts and deposits as well as expenditures and negotiated checks. Vouchers, payrolls and canceled checks were examined on a selective basis.

Excise tax collections were checked. Surety bond coverage was determined.

DEPARTMENTAL OPERATIONS

The departmental accounts showed that a net unexpended balance of \$431.16 was lapsed to surplus, per the following summary:

The overlay and overdrafts in the salary and interest accounts were the major factors contributing to the departmental balance lapsed.

* * *

The following comments pertain to the accompanying financial statements:

ASSETS The general cash balance of \$5,733.31 was on deposit in the Canal National Bank, Portland, Maine at February 14, 1970. Petty cash of \$25.00 was on hand with the treasurer-tax collector.

Taxes receivable of \$867.90 represented current year accounts of \$849.90 and 1968 accounts of \$18.00. Tax liens and tax acquired property amounted to \$24.00 and \$88.26 respectively at the year end.

LIABILITIES, RESERVES AND SURPLUS Notes payable of \$5,000.00 represents a short term anticipation loan for state aid road construction.

The departmental accounts showed a net unexpended balance of \$1,170.06 carried forward to the ensuing year in accordance with legal requirements and/or customary practice. The 1970 excise tax revenue was reserved for future allocations.

The unappropriated surplus amounted to \$3,795.34, an increase of \$670.08 for the year. This change was occasioned by the net unexpended departmental balance lapsed and a gain on the sale of tax acquired property less an adjustment to prior years carrying balances.

GENERAL

The use of 1969 excise tax revenue for town roads and contingent accounts was authorized by the townspeople at the annual town meeting. Also, the issuance of notes to assist in financing state aid road construction was voter authorized.

ART. 51. To see if the Town will authorize the Conservation Commission to make application for Federal financial assistance under the provision of the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act (Public Law,

88-578), for the acquisition of 1200 feet of frontage (approximately 7 acres) on the western shore of Clough Point (North end) for a conservation and recreation area; and that said land shall be owned and controlled by the Town of Westport.
