Pengoer July 10th 1841

Governor Washburn

We shall be ready
to start next Monday I want to know
how you will have us go, Col. Garrison was
very anxious for us to procure a wife
before we come away as the Government
are very slow & he thinks we will not
get any uniform for months if we do not
get it here I wrote to Goodwin yesterday
but have not heard from him yet
please answer immediately
