A Proclamation by the Governor.

In accordance with the constitution and beautiful custom, fitting in itself, and endeared to the people of New England, by an unbroken observance of more than two centuries, I do hereby invite the advice and consent of the Executive Council appoint

THURSDAY, THE 19th DAY OF APRIL NEXT,

as a day of fasting and prayer. And I do recommend to the citizens of the State that they be observed throughout its borders in a manner becoming an enlightened and Christian people; that on that day in the homes and in the accustomed places of public worship they do not forget to acknowledge the power, the unspeakable goodness and loving kindness of Him who is the God and Father of all men and individuals; that they confess the sins of the past and consecrate their future to the Heavenly Father, the giver of every good and perfect gift; and whose mercy endureth forever.

Given at the Council Chamber at Augusta, this thirtieth day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight, and of the Independence of the United States of America, the one hundred and twentieth.

But to the Prince himself the occasion must have forced itself into unpleasant comparison with that other birthday three years ago, when the old Emperor "kissed him many times," and gave to him as a special mark of favor a large portrait of his royal self. Bismarck himself in the "Globe" thought it worth the effort, the weight of years, and must be conscious that he is gradually slipping off the stage when the play is nearing the most exciting point.

M. Floquet, the Radical Republican whom President Carnot has summoned to form a ministry, was his political spurs in a novel way. The Motion for a New Trial.

The motion for a new trial of Stain and Cromwell, which their attorneys, Messrs. Barker and Gillen presented in court at Bangor, yesterday, is a very interesting document. Eleven reasons are urged why a new trial should be granted, which may be summed up briefly as follows:

1. Because one Millard E. Mudgett of Bangor has succeeded in demonstrating that it would not have been a physical impossibility for Mr. Barron to have locked himself into the safe without a screw driver; but that, on the contrary, Mr. Barron might have done it with a pen knife, or even a ten cent piece.
2. Because credible witnesses have since the trial established the fact that Charles F. Stain did not live at Medfield during the entire year of 1877 and until January 1878, as he testified that he did; but that he was in Maine.
3. Because it can be proved that Francis M. Bowman, who testified that he was the proprietor of the Farmer's Hotel in Augusta, in 1877, and that the unknown man who was declined to register, took dinner with him on July 28th, in reality was not the proprietor of the hotel at that time, nor did he have any interest there.
4. Because it can be proved that Wheeler the Medfield stable keeper, never owned a mare "Flora," or a horse "Star," the animals which young Stain testified he and his father went to Dexter in July and November, 1877.
5. Because expert locksmiths of New York and Bangor declare that the locks on the doors of the Dexter Savings Bank were of such a kind that no impression could be taken from which keys could be made, as young Stain testified they were made after the preliminary trials.
6. Because the resemblance between the handwriting of the elder Stain and that of the E. C. Sanborn signature on the Star of the East record of Nov. 20, 1877, is merely accidental, as can be shown by the testimony of one B. C. Sanborn, of Lowell, Mass., who will testify that he shipped a horse and a two-seated wagon from Boston to Gardiner on Nov. 20, 1877.
7. Because it can be proved by several new and reliable witnesses that David L. Stain was in Medfield and not in Dexter on the 22nd of February, 1878, when J. Wilson Barron was found dead.
8. Because it can be proved by several new and reliable witnesses that David L. Stain was in Medfield and not in Dexter on the 22nd of February, 1878, when J. Wilson Barron was found dead.

For establishing all these very important points the counsel rely upon the testimony of a large number of witnesses residing both in Maine and Massachusetts. The question naturally arises: "Why were these witnesses brought forward at the trial?" The reason which the petitioners give is that some of them were very reluctant to admit any knowledge of the case previous to and at the time of the trial, because the newspapers were full of sensational stories, and because anyone who made any statements in favor of the accused men was liable to be mis-reported, or worse still, to find himself discredited by zealous newspaper partisans of the prosecution. Not thinking that Stain and Cromwell would be convicted these witnesses did not feel their duty to tell what they knew. But

within forty-eight hours after the verdict of guilty, the counsel for the defense received about forty letters and telegrams from persons who knew of testimony favorable to Stain and Cromwell. It is the duty of the court and of the court alone to decide whether a new trial shall be granted, and asked for in the petition. Perhaps the evidence may not stand the test of careful examination. If it is competent to prove that Charles F. Stain's story is false in such essential details as the account of the two journeys to Maine in 1877 one of the mainstays of the prosecution will be swept away; if it is competent to establish the *alibi* referred to in the Eleventh item of the petition, the whole case against Stain and Cromwell must of course fall.
