To the Hon. Gov. & Council
for the State of Maine }

The undersigned agent for the Penobscot
Tribe of Indians respectfully represents that the sum of
six hundred dollars is now necessary for the purchase of
the Spring dividend to be made to said Indians the
first of May. Also the sum of four hundred dollars
the amount appropriated to said Tribe for agricultural
purposes. Also the sum of 25¢ for Governor's Salary 25¢
for Newell Saul, 25¢ for Francis Penias 15¢ for Peter
Secolar & 15¢ for John Fransway, appropriated to them
on account of loss by fire, amounting to the sum of
Eleven hundred and five dollars. He therefore respectfully
asks a warrant to be drawn in his favor for said
sum.
