## Preface

This report contains revised 2002 and 2003 annual average labor force estimates for Maine, its 16 counties, 35 labor market areas, and more than 500 cities, towns, unorganized townships, and plantations. Civilian labor force estimates for Maine and substate areas in Maine are developed by the Maine Department of Labor in cooperation with the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics. These estimates are preliminary benchmarks, pending final validation from the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The data was developed by the Maine Department of Labor using “the population-claimant allocation procedure” as recommended by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics. It should be noted that the smaller the city or town for which the estimates are derived, the less reliable the estimates.

A companion publication, *Maine Employment Statistical Handbook, 2003*, to be released later this year, provides detailed information on nonfarm wage and salary employment by industry for Maine and its 35 labor market areas; hours and earnings of production workers in manufacturing for Maine and the Portland and Lewiston-Auburn Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs); and current and historical employment, wages, and contributions covered under the Maine Employment Security Law. Together these publications provide detailed statistics used by education, training and guidance professionals, economic and industrial development specialists, market researchers, and others.

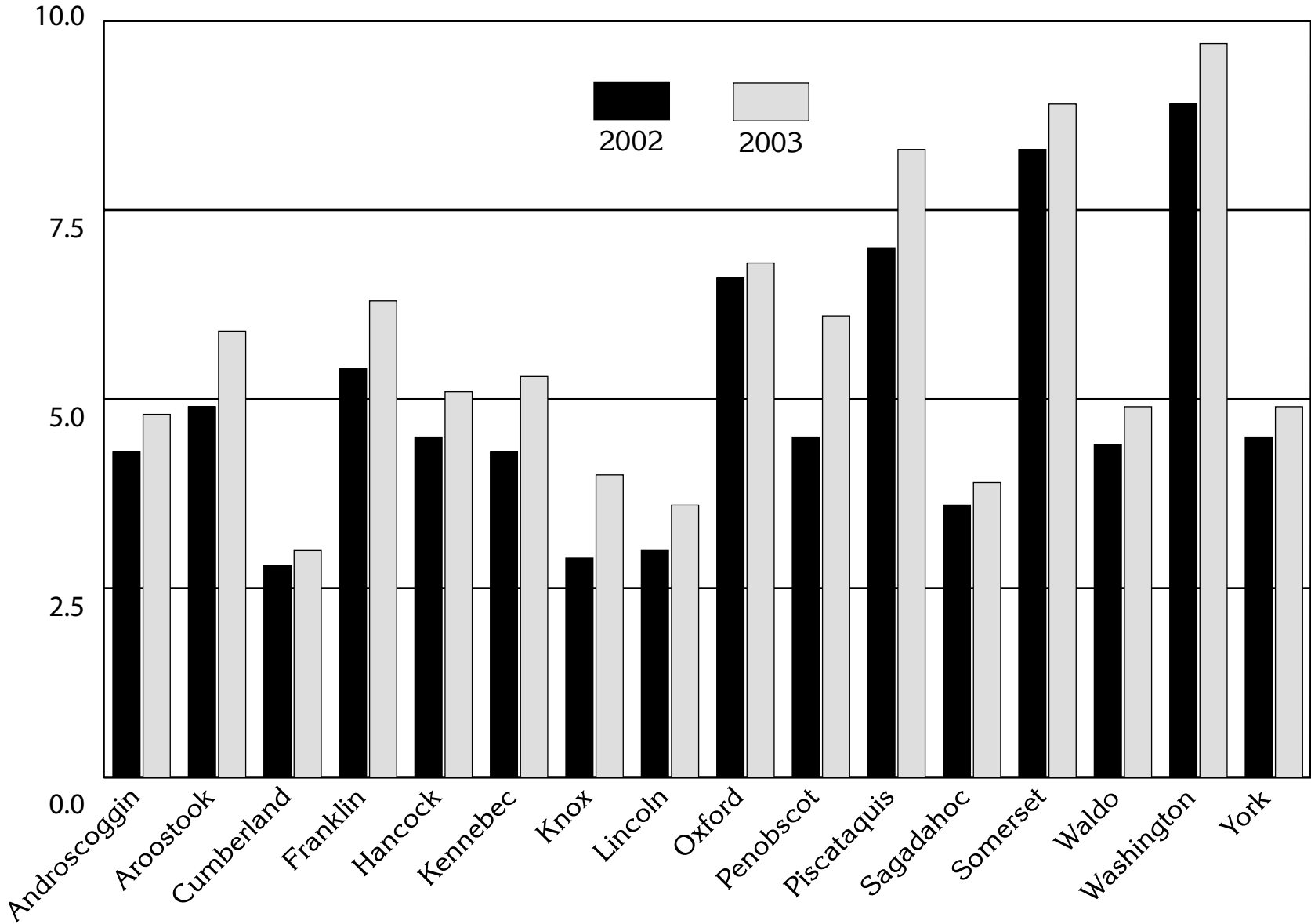

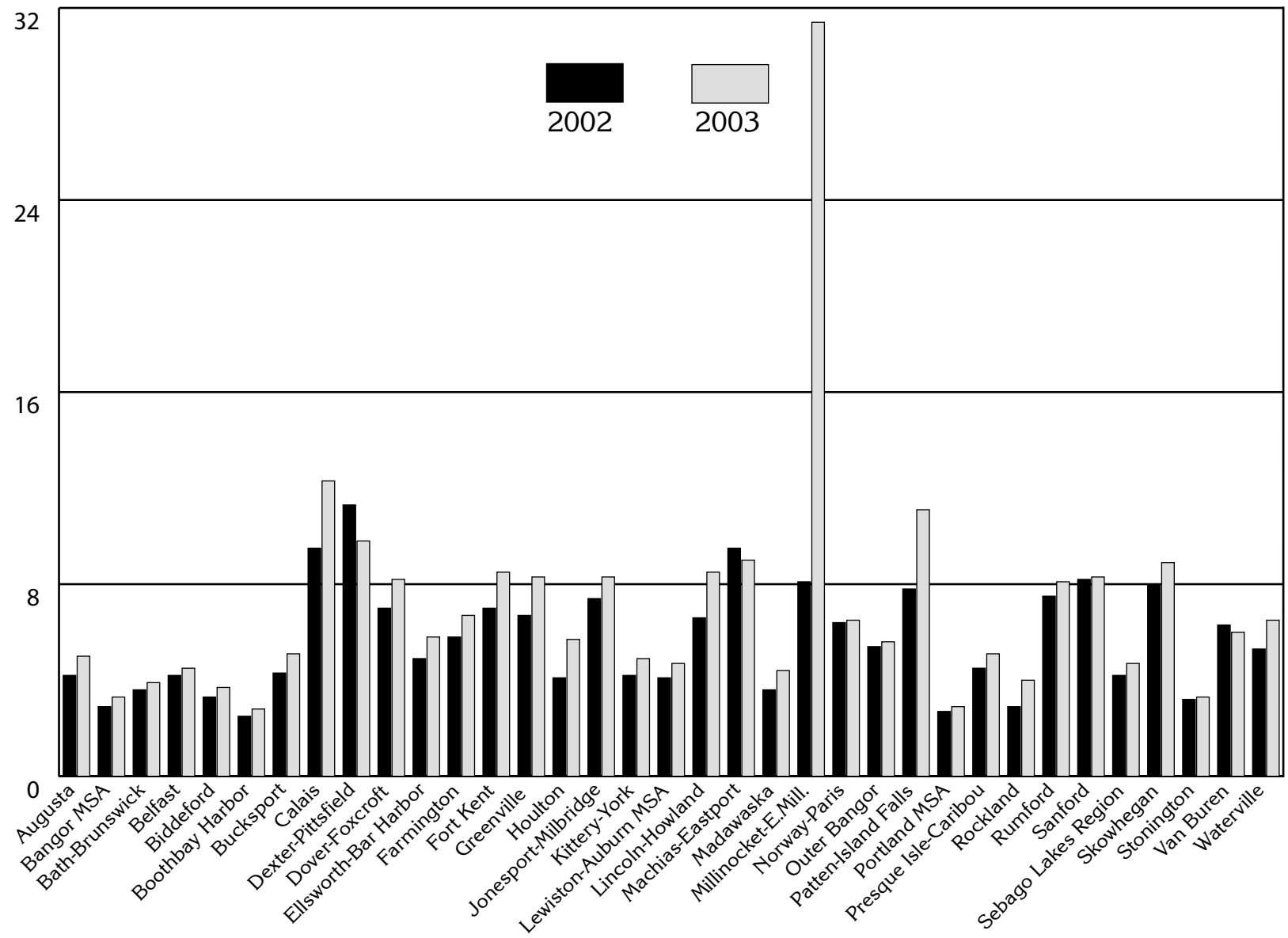
# Unemployment Rates for Maine Counties

## Annual Averages, 2002-2003

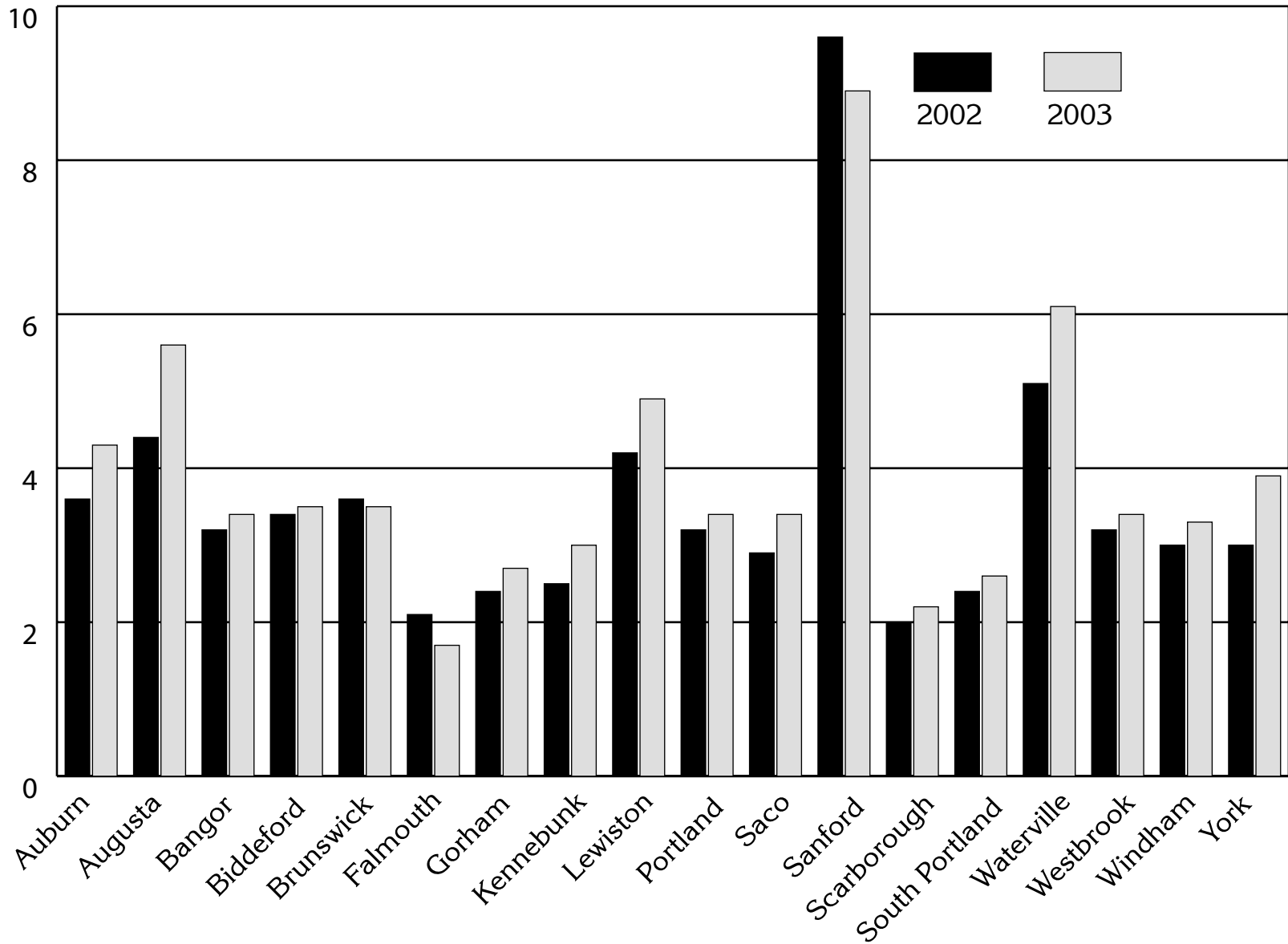


# Unemployment Rates for Maine Labor Market Areas
