Memorandum of an agreement entered into  
this twenty sixth day of August A.D. 1839, by  
and between Wentworth P. Files & Hetherly Barstow  
of Portland on the one part, and the State of  
Maine by Samuel Hazelton of said Portland,  
Agent for said State, on the other part.

Witnesseth, That the said Files & Barstow  
have engaged & agreed, and do hereby engage  
& agree to build upon the State land at the  
Arsenal in said Portland, a Cistern, which  
shall be eleven feet deep in the clear, and  
eight feet in diameter in the clear, and to  
lay a drain to carry off the waister water  
from the same; and the said Files and  
Barstow are to furnish all the materials  
for the same, except the stone to cover  
the Cistern, which stone they are to place  
and fit upon said Cistern; the same to be  
done & finished within fifty days & warranted  
to be tight for a reasonable length of time.  
And said State of Maine by said Hazelton,  
Agent as aforesaid, hereby engages & agrees to  
pay for said Cistern, as soon as the same  
shall be completed, according to this con-  
tract, the sum of seventy five dollars in full  
for the same.
