Will you have the kindness to send the receipts to him at Augusta for his signature.

My Order was not sent back & I think it is at the State House already.

We have received our overcoats & caps. The Regiment improves daily - Arms clean, good clothes, sick recovering. Some poor fellows are waiting a discharge.

Mr Drew's brother has not yet been heard from. I would not give up hopes of his return yet. Every day somebody turns up that we thought was killed or a prisoner -
