dispatch as possible to Lee's town, some seven
miles from Washington on 7th Street road, and
report to Maj General Bumside for assignment
to his Corps.

Your regiment will take two days
rations in haversacks and will be provided
with 40 rounds of ammunition in cartridges
boxes and must march without tents
