Gen. Hodgdon.

Sir, I write to learn any information in regard to a private in Co. F, 22^d Maine Regt. Frank Bracy which you may have at your office and be pleased to send me. Bracy enlisted at Alfred last Spring (March I think if not February) was taken sick the first of July and sent to the Division hospital in Va. and from there the Surgeon of the Regt. Dr Kimball write me was probably transferred North if alive, but the records of the Regt. were in so

confused a state that they
could not tell whether any
notice of his death had been
sent in or not. Please inform
me if any record of his death
has been sent to your office
or anything by which I can
learn whether he is alive or dead
as his friends would like
to hear from him if living
and if dead the circumstances
of his death
