

# State of Maine.

Resolves relating to the Penobscot Indians.

Resolved, that there be paid from the fund of the Penobscot Indians to the Agent of said tribe, one hundred dollars to be by him expended in repairing the Chapel belonging to said tribe on Oldtown Island.

Resolved — That the Agent of said tribe be authorized to sell at public auction all the hay, potatoes, oats, beans and straw raised on the public farm on Ordon Island and now on hand, also the farming tools belonging to said farm, and pay over to the treasurer of State the proceeds thereof for the benefit of said Indians.
