2nd Regiment, Maine Vols, Camp Rice
Near Ft. Corcoran, Arlington Heights Va,
Augt. 19. 1861

Sir,

I was engaged 12 days enlisting men at Oldtown
& conducting them from Oldtown to Falls Church Va,
We laid in Washington 3 days - before we could get to
Falls Church - & here I paid out expenses for the
security of the men 7th Please to forward to H. P. Sewall
Oldtown, whatever amt. you choose to allow me
for services together with the 7th expenses - my children
need it. I will consider it a great favor if you will
have this done as early as possible.

Benjamin Florents &

Frank Violette both of Oldtown deserted
in Boston - Irony Spencer of Milford Maine

George Kimball of Brighton Mass both
deserted in Washington - they had received
bounty and clothing -

I send you morning Report - Our Regiment Sunday Augt 18
everything very quiet now - In heart
yours truly
