Port of *Frank* is Master, for the present voyage, now lying in the
Bleedhill and bound for *Boston* To say:

*Fourteen Hundred & ninety four Bushels
and forty nine Bbs Potatoes
& more or less, all on board to be delivered*

being marked and numbered as in the margin, and are to be delivered in like good order and condition, at the aforesaid Port of *Boston* (the danger of the Seas only excepted,) unto *Peter McIntyre & Co*

or to Assigns, he or they paying Freight for the said Goods, *one hundred & ten Dollars (\$110)* with *our* Prime and Average accustomed....IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Master of the said vessel hath affirmed to *three* Bills of Lading, all of this tenor and date, one of which being accomplished, the others to stand void.
