Company Books & papers of the Maine vols
Said books & papers are now stored
in the City - Having been left at Annapolis
Va. & since forwarded to Washington

You will also look up absentees
from the Regiment & obtain if possible a
correct & complete account of Sick volun-
teers of the Maine Vols, now in various
Hospitals between this point & Washington

You will rejoin your Regiment at
the earliest practicable moment
