being marked and numbered as in the margin, and are to be delivered in like good order and condition, at the aforesaid Port of *Roanoke River N.C.* (the danger of the Seas only excepted,) unto *J. M. Rivers & Co.*

or to Assigns, he or they paying Freight for the said Goods,

*twelve and one half cents per cubic foot delivered,*

with *out* Primage and Average accustomed....IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the

Master of the said vessel hath affirmed to *three* Bills of Lading, all of this tenor and date, one of which being accomplished, the others to stand void.
