Dear Mr. Lawson:

I am enclosing an application for a Prospector's Permit with the Maine Mining Bureau. You may fill it out and return it to this office for a Permit. The Mining Bureau will be meeting on September 27 and one of the subjects on the agenda is a discussion of your proposed request for transfer of the King Resources Company acreage to Scurry-Rainbow.

As you may know, the Mining Bureau has recently extended the mining act to include an Oil and Gas Control and Development Law which covers all phases of oil exploration, drilling and production on the land and water areas of the State of Maine. In at least some parts of your activity there will be a requirement to abide by this new Section of our minerals law.

I hope that it will be my pleasure to meet you in person in Maine in the near future.
