





tor. The deceased officer was a native of Maryland, but a citizen of Pennsylvania, from which State he was appointed to the United States navy. He entered the service on the 25th of May, 1802, and steadily advanced himself through the various grades until he reached the highest ranks. His name at the outbreak of the war, in 1861, stood forty-seventh on the list of captains. Higher promotion was denied him when he resigned. At this time he held the honorable rank of rear admiral in the Washington navy yard. Immediately after his resignation, it is said, he repented of the step, and petitioned to be reinstated; but this the government pertinently refused, and Buchanan went over to the rebels. The admiral, however, remained in the service, and commanded the Confederate naval forces at Mobile. At the conclusion of the war he resigned the office, and returned to his native city.
