General:

I am directed by the Secretary of War to inform you that the Annual Return of the Militia of your State, called for in the communication from this office of November 6, 1879, has not yet been received.

By Section 232 of the Revised Statutes of the United States the Secretary of War is required to lay before Congress on or before the first Monday in February of each year, an abstract of the militia returns of the several states as furnished by the Adjutants General thereof.

In order therefore, that this requirement may be promptly met, it is necessary that your return should be
