Dear Sir

Please inform
Burnham Morrill where
to apply for the Town
County of his son, "Stephen
J. Morrill" of Co. A. 16th Regt.
He enlisted in June, last
and when the Town voted
to pay a County he applied
to Chesterville, (the place of his
father's residence) for the County.
As he enlisted before they
voted to pay the County,
and as he was not a
citizen of Chesterville, the
Selectmen refused to
except him as one of
their gotta.

Fayette lacked over

Man, and he applied to
them and they took him
into their quota just
before he left the State.

Afterwards, Chesterwille
lucked one man and
tried to have him trans-
ferred to their list.

Chesterwille has no claim
on him at all.

Chesterwille & Fayette both
refuse to pay the bounty
now, as they say they don't
know which town he goes
for.

Please let "Barnham Morrill
South Chesterwille" know what
town to apply to for the Bounty,
as he needs it very much,
and can get it by having
a writing from you to show
what town he represents - he has
orders from his town to collect it.
