being marked and numbered as in the margin, and are to be delivered in like good order and condition, at the aforesaid Port of *Philadelphia* (the danger of the Seas only excepted,) unto *Clark McClellan W. Kennedy* or to Assigns, he or they paying Freight for the said Goods, *two hundred and thirty seven dollars and fifty cents \$237.50*

with *out* Primage and Average accustomed. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Master of the said vessel hath affirmed to *three* Bills of Lading, all of this tenor and of which being accomplished the others to stand void.
