82 Pieces rough Granite dimension  
Stone making 1848-10 feet more or less

being marked and numbered as in the margin, and are to be delivered in like good order and  
condition, at the aforesaid Port of Philadelphia (the cargo of the Seas  
only excepted,) unto Clark McClellan H. Kennedy or to Assigns, he or  
they paying Freight for the said Goods, two hundred and thirty  
seven dollars and fifty cents \$237.50

with out Primage and Average accustomed. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Master of the said  
vessel hath affirmed to three Bills of Lading, all of this tenor and of the one of which  
being accomplished the others to stand void.
