MyHeritage Added

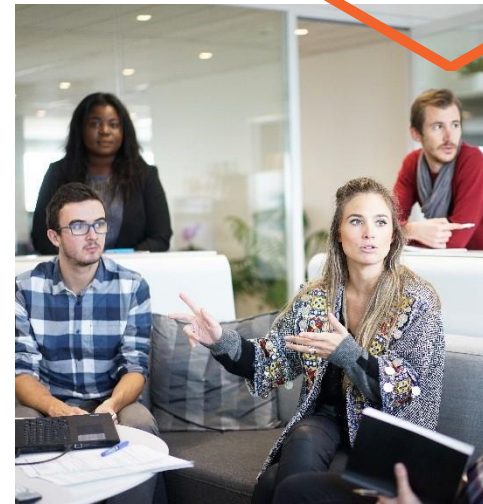
As part of the updated Digital Maine Library resources, the Maine State Library has added **MyHeritage** to the databases available to Maine residents.

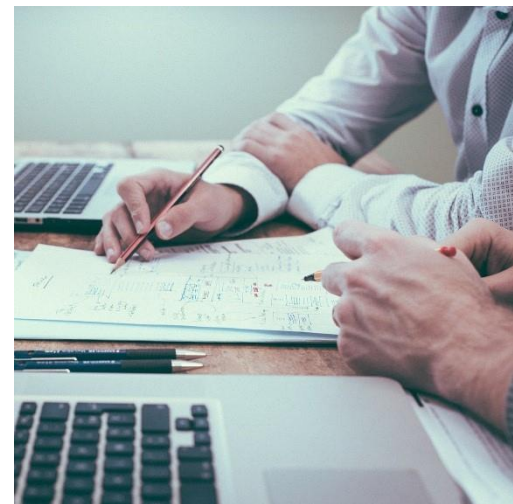
