Adft Gen. Woodson;

Dear sir;

Col Sewell

informs me that I can keep my men here until the middle of August - that is; allow them to stay here for the purpose of securing their hay crop - I presume you have an understanding in relation to this. I shall subject Maj Coulter to the expense of no more than one week's board for any single regiment - and that shall not exceed if it comes up to the amount allowed by law - I understand that this will be perfectly satisfactory -
