or to Assigns, he or they paying Freight for the said Goods,

twelve and one half cents per cubic foot Government Measurement
with *out* ~~Primage~~ and Average accustomed....IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Master of the said vessel hath affirmed to *three* Bills of Lading, all of this tenor and date, one of which being accomplished, the others to stand void.
