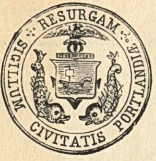

Portland, Me. January 21<sup>st</sup> 1880

"General Beal"

Dear Sir,

Can a certified copy of Discharge be issued from your office in the case of Patrick Bisbee or Busby who formerly belonged to Co "D" - unassigned Infantry Captain George Fiske - Mustered in on or about March 1865 - Mustered out on or about May 1866. This Soldier we think is entitled to a home at "Togas", but his Discharge was destroyed in the Portland Fire July 4, 1866. If a Certified Copy can be sent - I shall take the proper steps to have him sent to the "Home", at Togas, believing this to be a worthy case, and desiring an early answer. I remain
