THE ROBINS CASE.

The Prisoner Committed.

Yesterday afternoon at 2 p. m. court came in and the prisoner, Charles T. Robbins, not being present, the Commissioner, Mr. Edward M. Rand, Mr. A. A. Stout, counsel for government, and the State Attorney, Mr. J. H. Murray, and the United States Deputy Marshal Willard proceeded to the jail. In the presence of the prisoner and the above named gentlemen the Commissioner, Mr. Rand, delivered his decision as follows:

Charles T. Robbins.—On the complaint of His Majesty John Murray, Her Britannic Majesty's Attorney General, and of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, you are committed to the custody of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and of your malice aforethought, killing and murdering Solomon Camp, and also with intent to kill, making an assault with a dangerous weapon, upon Andrew Scott, on the twenty-fourth day of May last, on the high seas, and on board the British steamer "Annie B," and within the admiralty jurisdiction of Her Britannic Majesty.

It has been most clearly proved that you committed the several crimes against you named to them on your behalf has been a suggestion of your insanity at that time.
