Sir:

Benj. Frazier Jr. of Otis enlisted after the Call for the draft was made. July 20<sup>th</sup> 1863. The town of Otis wish to have him put to the credit of the quota for that town. They are to pay a Bounty of \$250. which they offer to him if he has a certificate that he can be credited to the last Call for Volunteers.

You will confer a favor upon both Benj. Frazier & the town of Otis if you will or can furnish a certificate stating that he is accredited to that town

under the last Call.
