

I Warren Sawyer of Calais
do hereby agree to perform the following labor on a
Gun House in Calais, for Rindoe Whidden Esr.
Frame and raise the building - Board, shingle and
clapboard the same - Make one set of double doors with
pannels - One single panel door - Put on all the
trimmings - Make the sashes and window frames for
eight windows in the upper story - of twelve lights
each for 10 by 12 inch glass, and three windows
with shutters in the lower story, including all the
trimmings for the outside - Lay the floor in the lower
story, double, and a rough single floor in the upper.
All to be done in a workmanlike manner. The lower
floor to be planed - The whole to be completed by the
tenth day of December next. Also to set the posts
for underpinning said building. - For which the said
Rindoe Whidden is to pay to said Warren Sawyer the
sum of one hundred and forty dollars, and is
to furnish at the Town house in Calais, suitable ma-
terials for said building. - Said Gun House is to be
33 feet in length and 30 feet wide - the lower story
8 1/2 feet between joints and the upper story ten feet
studs.
