General:

I have the honor to enclose herewith  
the triplicate Enlistment of nine men,  
Eight Veterans, and one Recruit,

These are all countersigned by the Mustering  
Officer, Capt. W. H. W. Krebs, in consequence  
of an order being issued from the War Dept  
to the Mustering Office about the first of January,  
that they should countersign triplicates, instead  
of duplicates. — I have recruited Seventy-

Veteran for Co. "H" and Seventy-two Veterans  
for my own Comp'g. — If time for volun-
