Sir

Your favours of 4th 5th & 7th inst^s came
in by last evening's mail. I have the re-
port that Dr. Cane has resigned his posi-
tion as Temporary Surgeon & his resignation
has been accepted by the War Department.
The Medical department immediately order-
ed a surgeon to report here at once to act
with the Regular Assistant-Surgeon - That
is the way the thing stands at present time,
I should like to commend however that our own State
furnish the men for the Medical department &
its several Regiments, as well as other Officers,
believing we have as good material as can
be had from any section - Dr. Cane has in-
deed acted in a singular manner. He was content
to serve until active duties were about to commence
then for some reason has resigned & at a time when
a change is very disagreeable - I should think you
would be disgusted with mankind almost, from
the manner ~~man~~ he has acted in my Regiment at least -

I have received an appointment
by the President but the appointment is not
yet confirmed - I shall go with my Regiment

which leaves today by transport - report say
for Fort Monroe. I feel it my duty to go
I shall be joys & sorrows alike, until I am
confirmed & assigned to my new command.
The Vice President has kindly volunteered to look
after my interests in Washington which relieves
me from any care in that direction, & makes
me free to go with the Regiment -

I have tried to do my duty as
well as the 4th and have succeeded in hel-
ping the Regiment at the Head of the list
of Volunteer Regiments at War Department,
but my dear Sir - I could not have done it
had I not had your earnest support in
all my trials - You have commissined
on my recommendation in every case
where it could be done, & a better organ-
ized Regiment is not to be found in the
Army of the Potomac - Maine stands well
here her Regiments are second to none -
God Bless the Old State -

You ask me for my views
relative to future organization of the 4th I had a
difficulty in knowing exactly going out as I
am about to do. but as I hope to have it in my
Brigade - I still have an interest as great as ever
in its future organization - I would recom-
