## The Chellie's Colt.

Was four years old on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of May last. was sired by the Thompson Horse of Newfield whose dam was a fine mare owned by H. Wiggins of Great Falls N.H. and who was a descendant of the Old Hawk (so called) of New Hampshire. The Dam of the Chellie's Horse was sired by the Leopard a New Hampshire horse that has stood for mares in Newfield - and is a successful foal getter and whose stock is considered excellent. - The Grand Dam of the Chellie's Horse came from the John Doe mare called the Squirrel of New Parsonsfield. -

Since the Chellie's Horse was 20 months of age. he has been kept in stable - the first Winter he was fed with one pint of oats per day - the next Winter with 2 pints - the last Winter with about 2 quarts. - During the last mare season he was fed with about 4 quarts per day. - Since mare time. he has had no grain until recently - when he has been fed with about 3 quarts of green corn per day.
