I have the

Me. Regt. and would earnestly recom-
mend that they be commissioned to the
positions herein named.

1st Lieut. Isaac A. Pound, Co. A.

to Capt. Co. A. vs Capt S. H. Robinson
resigned. Date from January 25/63.

2nd Lieut. Francis A. Wildes to

1st Lieut. Co. A. vs. Pound promoted.
Date from January 25/63.

1st Sergeant Emilus N. Small to, A.

to 2nd Lieut. Co. A. vs Wildes promoted,
Date from January 25/63.

Soon after the battle of Fredericksburg,
I forwarded to Gen. Warblum names
to fill vacancies in the different com-
panies, in the Regt. Among the number
were Sergeant Warren of Company "F."
to said Lieut. Co. "F." as Deering promoted
also Sergeant Fred H. Beecher Co. "B." to
said Lieut. Co. "B." as Edwards promoted.

The commissions for the above named
persons have not been received at
these Ad Quarters. Will you please
^{cause} the same to be forwarded as soon as
convenient.

We also need a Commissioner appointed
for the Regiment and would respectfully
recommend Capt. Wm. H. Waldron of
Co. "D." as well fitted for the position.
