Hon Abner Coburn

Sir—

I write
you at the present time to solicit
your assistance to enable Mr Geo, F
Strong procure his discharge from
his Regiment,

He enlisted in August last
in the 16th Regt of Me Vols and
since he left Augusta has not been
able to do service with his regiment

He has been most of the time
in the Hospital—going out in
Jan and returning the 1st of the same
month,

I am informed by a member of the
16th that there is no prospect of his
being able for service if he remains
And while he can be of no possible
benefit to his Country where he is
he owes it at home take care of
his family himself while it now

comes out of the country to which
he is of no possible service
And while it can be but an act
of strict justice to him and to humanity
it is also justice and a benefit to his
country.

He is at Washington in the Hospital
hoping you will render me what
aid and you consistently can in
procuring this discharge
