

Waterville Feb. 16th 1863.

Gov. A. Brown:

Dear Sir:- At the suggestion of Mr. Boothby, who tells you that you have mentioned the matter to him, I take occasion to communicate with you in reference to the vacancy existing in my Company ("E.- 16th Me. Vol.) -
