



Head Quarters, Third Maine Regiment,

Adjutant's Office,

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The 3^d Maine Regiment went into
camp at Augusta Maine on ground in
front of State House designated as
"Camp Hamlin". (Was mustered into service of
United States by Capt Thos. Hight.
June 4th). In compliance with orders
left Camp Hamlin at 5 a.m. Wednesday June
5th for Washington by rail via Boston to
Fall River, thence by boat "Bay State"
arriving in New York at 4 A.M. Sunday
June 7th. Left N.Y. at 4 P.M. by boat to Amboy,
thence by rail to Washington arriving
at 8 P.M. Friday June 7th. At 3 P.M. June 8th
Left Quarters in City for camp on
Meridian Hill designated as
"Camp Morrill"

July 6th Left Camp Morrill - by boat to
Alexandria Va. - marched thence to camp
on Run 1 1/2 miles S.W. Alex.^a & pitched tents
designating the station as —

"Camp Washburn", which camp was left
July 11th for Clement 3 1/2 miles S.W.
of Alex^a.

At 2 P.M. July 16th left station at Clement
& after a march of about 12 miles S
W. from Alex^a, bivouaced on west side of
"Accotink creek" July 17 at 2 o'clock A.M.
at 4 A.M. marched to "Dungen Station"
& bivouaced.

July 17th in the afternoon took up a
line of march & at 2 A.M. July 18th
bivouaced at Centerville

Centerville July 21st at 2 A.M. left for "Bull
Run" - was in engagement - fell
back to Centerville & in compliance
with orders retreated towards

Alexandria - halting at Fairfax
C.B. for rest 1 1/2 hours - arriving
in Alexandria at 11 A.M. July 22

Alexandria July 23rd Left quarters in city
for old camp at Clement.

Aug. 14th Struck tents & pitched
them on Hay Hill just west of
Fort Ellsworth at 11 P.M.

Station on Lurberg Road

"Hay Hill" Removed to Hay Hill 1 1/2 miles
North Fort Ellsworth at 12 M.

Designating the station as
"Camp Firsden"

Oct 2nd left Camp Firsden &
pitched tents on Old Fairfax
road about 3 miles S.W. of Alex^a
& 1 1/2 miles west of "Fort Lyon" &
designating the station as
"Camp Howari", at which station the
Regiment got remaining.
