To the Adjutant General

State of Maine

Sir - I have the honor
to report that at an election
held at Camp Preble, Portland
Maine, June 16th (or as near that
date as can be ascertained) one
which Mr Major Samuel C Ham-
ilton presided. First Lieutenant
Henry R. Millett was duly
elected Second Lieutenant
vice John Sherrill. appointed
Quartermaster.

The record of the above
election is missing and there can
be no doubt was lost with
the other Regimental papers at the
Battle of Bull Run July 21st 1861

The morning Report of Co. A.
was accepted as correct by Col
Dunnell, it called for two
Lieutenants and the said
Mullett was named there on
as the second.

All the Regimental details and
Records recognize the said
Mullett as a second Lieuten-
ant, both previous to and
~~after~~ July 2nd and until
elected Captain
