I had today your report
 together with the three returns for correction.

I have now read 200 men musters.
 There are some more on the ground but not
 enough to make up a full Regt. The rejected men
 I keep on a separate muster in rolls: If I un-
 derstood my instructions aright the Co's were to
 put on their rolls all men of this Co's which were re-
 jected; many Capt's destroyed their rejected papers after
 getting the signature of surgeon, not thinking it necessary to
 preserve them,

The papers of Gen. H. Key and Samuel A.
 Greasy were sent yesterday: it seems they were trans-
 ferred from the 19th by special order No. 15: but Capt.
 Stirkland informs me that the men remain with the
 19th so I will return the papers to you.
