## THE MOST IMPORTANT STATE NEWS BRIEFLY TOLD.

The first salmon was taken from Bangor Ford Saturday, the 3d. It weighed 14 3/4 pounds.

John Jones of Lebanon lost an arm in a machine in the lumber mill at that place Thursday.

Lebanon will have a special city election to choose a mayor to succeed Mayor Noble, and candidates are numerous.

Buckport has a name for the enthusiastic citizens who planted peas a week or more ago; it is "early vegetable jockey."

A Portland milkman with 18 years of experience says the condition of the highways this spring is the worst he has ever known.

The Augusta pension office is not to be discontinued as President Cleveland intended, after all, and Gen. Connor has been nominated as pension agent.

When they speak of "constitutionalism," at Bar Harbor, nowadays, they mean a round trip of the bay in the Sebastes and they say the invigorating sea breeze is better than spring medicine.

Two tramps were arrested at Bangor Monday night for a bold robbery committed that afternoon at Allen's second hand store, the men breaking the window and taking several watches while the proprietor was at dinner.
