

To The Hon. Israel Washburn Governor of Maine

The Subscribers respectfully represent  
that Orpheus Roberts, a private in Co. I. 4<sup>th</sup> Reg.  
Maine V.M. enlisted at Belfast about the first of October  
1861 under the orders of Lieut. P. H. Gray with the promise  
and understanding that he would have an office in the  
company which was to be raised - that after enlisting  
about forty men, an arrangement was made to form a  
Co. by joining with a squad raised at Bangor & elsewhere  
that said Roberts was induced to waive his claim to a  
lieutenancy by the offer of the place of first sergeant  
in said new Co. which went into the 4<sup>th</sup> Reg as Co. H.  
he accepted the place and acted as first sergeant  
and Clerk of said Co H until after it ~~joined~~  
the Reg. in Virginia when without any good reason  
as we believe he was ~~removed~~ from said place and  
reduced to the ranks as a private and that afterward  
he was transferred from said Co H. to Co I of the same  
regiment. that in our opinion said Roberts is entirely  
competent to perform the duties of a lieut and that  
we believe that great injustice is done to him by his  
having being deprived of the office and pay which he had a right  
to expect and continuing to do duty as a private.

We therefore respectfully ask that your Excellency will appoint  
said Orpheus Roberts to the office of second lieutenant

in Co. I of the fourth Reg.
