I respectfully forward for your
information the following report of the part
taken by my command in the late movements
near Fredericksburg
Struck Camp & left winter camp at 12 M. April
28th ult. & marched to & bivouacked near White Oak
Church distance 5 miles -
April 29th 30th & May 1st in line of battle near
Woods 5 miles below Falmouth
May 2nd marched to & crossed River at U.S. Ford
(18 miles) at 7^{1/2} M. formed in line of battle on
extreme right of line & remained in position until
May 6th when we crossed the river at 7^{1/2} M. & marched
to & bivouacked near White Oak Church
Enclosed I send you "List of Casualties".
