Whatever Gov. Hill is not a hypocrite. He openly avows his friendship for the saloon man and ostentatiously courts their support.

The Democratic national committee appeals to the people for contributions. The office holders have been muted to the limit of endurance, and the people are called upon to assist. Chairman Barnum should send his circular over into the British provinces. There the people apparently feel more interest in the re-election of Mr. Cleveland than do the people of the United States, and there the responses are likely to be much more numerous and liberal.

The digging up and publishing of a letter alleged to have been written by the late Mr. McKim in 1870 is the latest mark of the Democratic party. It is carried on by Mr. Brice. Of course the motive is to revive the animosities of the New York Democrats. But the purpose is not obvious altogether to succeed. Like President Cleveland's retaliation message it is likely to accomplish nothing but to show what desperate straits the Democracy are in.

In the table of the vote of Maine cities and towns upon the constitutional amendment the vote of Saco was transposed, so that that city appeared as having voted against the treasury amendment and in favor of annual sessions. The revenue was the case. The vote on the amendment limiting the term of State treasurer was 186 in favor to 36 opposed; and on the amendment in regard to the sessions of the Legislature was 186 in favor to 37 opposed. Augusta is the only city in the State that voted in favor of annual sessions. The explanation of her vote is easy.

The Cincinnati Commercial-Gazette reminds the Hon. Allen G. Thurman, who has recently been pointing out to the colored people of the country the great obligations they are under to the Democratic party, of the fact that in 1867, when he ran as a candidate for Governor of Ohio against Gen. Hayes, the Democratic ticket bore a negro head, beneath which was the legend, "This is a white man's government," and a big "C" for the constitutional amendment forbidding disfranchisement on the ground of race, color or previous condition of servitude.

8. Corning Judd, the postmaster of Chicago who has just resigned, proved himself extremely unfit for his position more than two years ago. Complaints from the business men of Chicago have come ever since his administration began till and fast to the postoffice department that the Chicago service was badly demoralized and needed a new head. But Judd was a Democrat, and spite of his well known inefficiency he was retained in one of the most important offices in the country. He has now kindly consented to resign and relieve Postmaster General Dickinson of his embarrassment.

The worst alleged indignity press has to say of the removal of Superintendent Jackson of the railway mail service to make room for a Democratic candidate that it is unfortunate and may have a bad effect upon Mr. Cleveland's canvass. One can easily imagine what these true moral sheets would have said had Mr. Blaine been the President under this outrageous violation of the spirit of civil service reform had been committed. The English language would not have furnished adjectives strong enough to express their indignation. But Cleveland is for free trade and with the independent press this is a virtue big enough to cover a vast multitude of sins.

Some men are born great and some make themselves great. The Hon. C. B. Kilgore of Texas is one of the latter kind. But Mr. Kilgore made himself great in none of the ways by which Congressmen usually acquire distinction. He did not make a great speech, he did not introduce a great measure, and he has never displayed any more than ordinary aptitude for public affairs. But through the grace of Speaker Carlisle he became chairman of the committee on enrolled bills, and while acting in that capacity there came into his hands a bill which it was his duty to place in the hands of the President. It was his attitude in regard to the performance of this duty that has conferred enduring fame upon Mr. Kilgore. When asked when he proposed to deliver the bill to the executive Kilgore replied that he should do so when he was ready, that he was boss of that bill and neither Congress nor the President nor anybody else could hurry him. Of course the boldness of this reply made a great impression upon the country and boomed him immensely in his district. He has since been named unanimously. Texas statesmen are becoming famous for their replies. It was a statesman from Texas who uttered the famous reply to a citizen of New Haven who asked him a question—"Go home and soak your head."

A correspondent of the Boston Journal suggests that the yellow fever epidemic at the South presents a good opportunity for the Christian scientists to demonstrate the correctness of their theory of disease. Here are whole communities, fleeing like sheep from a disease which is supposed to have a real existence and in a large per cent. cases to be beyond the power of the ordinary physicians to cure. Now if the Christian scientist can demonstrate that yellow fever exists only in the imagination, that the patient burning up with fever is but the victim of a delusion which exists only in his mind, that, in short, nothing ails him, what a boon he will confer upon the people of the far South. These scientists tell us that they have no doubt of the correctness of their theory. They ought therefore not to hesitate to act in accordance with it. Let one of them take his stand by the bedside of a yellow fever patient in Jacksonville and convince him that nothing is the matter with him. If he can do this Christian science will have received an impetus which it never can receive as long as it depends on the prayer and obscure lectures of its devotees and alleged healers. It is a little sick. Here is a glorious opportunity for some Christian scientist to immortalize his name and knock all the various pathies higher than a kite. Who will volunteer to go to Jacksonville and speak the plague and the panic? Don't all stay at once.

Wants a Certificate.
Governor Hill of New York is growing restive under the bitter warfare the Mugwumps are making upon him. Asked what he was feeling in regard to the attitude of the New York City Times toward him, he replied:

Upon me? Well, I'll speak plainly. There are some people in the ranks and file who don't think it is quite the thing to do to attack me. I should attack me so seriously when I'm doing all I can to win for Cleveland. I don't think that the national leaders ought to squander time in newspapers and magazines in attacking my little circle and Mr. Cleveland believe that I am above his party. I don't think I should be squandered. The Times has always been buzzing about me. When a great man is in the line, I don't want to be right over to the Republican ranks. No, I don't really believe a single word will scratch Mr. Cleveland because the Mugwump press don't like me.

This appears to be a rather thinly disguised intimation to Mr. Cleveland that unless he can call off the Mugwump sheets, or directly repudiate their utterances, he is likely to find himself on election day subjected to a "knifing" process. The Governor's friends are using even less diplomacy. Thus the

New York Sun notifies the President that Hill is assailed by "traitors and miscreants" and that he should not delay too long in speaking out boldly and emphatically for his friend. The Sun wants Hill given just such a certificate of good character as the President gave Col. Felt. When the latter was running for district attorney, and when to quote the Sun's language the "foul and malignant Republican" character as the President was assailing with calumny and vituperation that faithful and stalwart servant of the people. Whether Hill gets his certificate depends upon the opinion of the President of his effect upon his own canvass. It is to keep quiet will imperil less votes than to speak out, then Cleveland will keep quiet, but if the prospect, be it contrary, then an endorsement of Hill and his candidacy quite as emphatic as was given Felt will be forthcoming. That moral considerations will have no weight in the matter is sufficiently demonstrated by the fact that Felt was got an endorsement in spite of the fact that he was utterly unfit, morally and mentally, for the office to which he was nomin.

NEW PUBLICATIONS.

Studies in Criticism. By Florence Trail. It is impossible not to be reminded in reading this book of the gentleman whose "fable was omniscience." Miss Trail—who knows absolutely nothing about her, but, in spite of her condition, imagine her young, and not so very long out of a female college—is really learned, has, at least, read, a immense number of volumes and must have quite a remarkable memory, or she also keeps a greater number of notebooks, and far more methodically, than most of us can manage. The extent of this learning, if judged alone by its allusions, is fairly overpowering. She has philosophy, art, music, history, mythology, religions at her pen's end, and, really, let us be just,—says very good things upon many of her subjects. If she had only given us an index!

Assuredly, in a collection of quotations and historical and philosophical and literary and religious allusions like this, the want of an index is quite unexcusable. This book will have its largest value for students, (certainly it will require thoughtful readers) who wish to find summaries of ideas that are not ordinarily met with in the sources at our command. Thus the elaborate "Glimpses into French Literature," is, in reality, a condensed estimate of the literature of France from the Troubadour and Trouvère poetry to Balzac and Victor Hugo, and in this short compass more information, and often of very good quality, than we can, perhaps, lay out hands on easily elsewhere. The only warning we have is a suggestion that not all of Miss Trail's comments are to be taken as infallible. For example, though she says with perhaps over self-satisfaction that she has had "access to two versions of the original text" of The Song of Roland, and though we unblushingly confess it only knowing one single translation of this old chronicle of arms, yet we should not have dared to remark that "its relation is more like the vision of successive tableaux than that demand upon the fancy, memory, attention and reflective powers which one is accustomed to connect with the thought of a long poem." Of course, she really means that The Song of Roland is a narrative and descriptive poem, full of life and freedom, but she has actually contrived to make us question its actual poetic quality. She too summarily dismisses the influence of the original text of The Song of Roland, and though we unblushingly confess it only knowing one single translation of this old chronicle of arms, yet we should not have dared to remark that "its relation is more like the vision of successive tableaux than that demand upon the fancy, memory, attention and reflective powers which one is accustomed to connect with the thought of a long poem."

In uniform style with the Mother Goose Melodies, and also edited by "Uncle Will," is published Songs for Our Darlings, compiled by the Child's Book Club, and for Little Ones, Rhyme and Reason, Little Love, &c. The book is well illustrated, (Boston: Lee & Shepard; Portland: Loring, Short & Harmon.)
