Wm J. L. Hodsdon,

Adj: General of Maine.

Sir:

In answer to your enquiry as to ~~the~~
what I want of a copy of my Husbands
"enlistment papers" and "muster in"
Certificate I would say, that he
Dennis Driscoll enlisted in December
for the 1st Maine Heavy Artillery. At
the date of his enlistment that Regt.
was not full and the Recruiting Officer
promised to place him there but
neglecting to send him forward for a
week or two it was found when he
arrived in Belfast that the above
named Regt. was full. so he was
placed where he now is in the 2^d Maine
Battery. He desires to be transferred
to the Regt. for which he originally
enlisted, and informs me that

Capt. Thomas wished to procure
a copy of his enlistment papers for
what purpose I do not definitely know
but presume he thought they might
aid in procuring his transfer to the
1st Maine Heavy Artillery for which
as I before stated he originally enlisted.

This is all I know with regard to it.

If you will have the goodness to interest
yourself in procuring the accomplishment
of this act of justice you will thereby
confer a lasting favor
