

Portland Sept: 1 1864

Adjutant General Hedgeson -

I sent today more
enlistments; I could not send them
before as men kept coming in till
yesterday forenoon.

It seems that the surgeon made a
mistake with regard to Charles H. Abbott,
he should have been reported where he was
recorded as passed.

I think the transfers are all attended
to. It has been a sore reparation to me, but
I have endeavored to keep such matters
straight but doubtless some mistakes have
occurred.

I wish to know what compensation
a mustering officer receives and how
I must proceed to recover my pay for
mustering services; Dr. Lawkesby lived
in town and I was obliged to carry the
papers to him to be signed and I think
at Col. Hardy's said I was entitled to
pay therefor; will you not give me
instructions with regard to it and
oblige
