Dear Mr Colburn dear Sir it is with great  
pleasure i take my pen in hand to write you  
a few lines to let you know my situation has  
September i reciv'd a injury in my left side while  
on the march from Washington to Antietam which  
i have not been able to do duty ever since i have  
been in the hospital ever since and how much  
longer they will keep me is more than i can  
tell i do wish i could go to my regiment but  
i am not able to do any work yet i hope  
you will not take this as a insult ~~because~~ i  
wrote to you for i consider you a friend to every  
true man what i want to say to you is a  
bout my pay i have not reciv'd ne pay ever  
since i left main and i have to pay interest  
for highered money and i think if the money  
the government oltg me if i had it i could  
stop the intrest on what i highered at home  
i think when a man leaves home and friends  
and a place where he gets one dollar per day and  
~~leaves the state~~ in defence of his country  
he ought to have his pay when it is do him for  
what the pay master keeps back from the sick  
soldiers they git intrest on it and put in  
their own profits i think that intrest is  
just as good for me as it is for them ~~or~~ if

they are in mind to keep a man for months in  
the hospital sick they ought to pay him so  
he can meet his prog. wants at home or has a man  
besides he is free get to leave home friends and  
sacrifice his property for the sake of defending  
a rich man property or is he defending this govern-  
ment or what did they send out here for serving  
part I came out to put down this rebellion  
but I find the most of our head men is more for  
money than any thing else and I find our doctors  
~~are~~ care but little of the sick and if our head  
men is in mind to lead the soldiers in the field to  
have them shot down ~~down~~ and gain no victory  
why is it I should like to write more on this for  
I have not time I wish you as a friend would  
try and let me know how I can earn my  
pay if you can and I will be greatly obliged  
to you and thank you as a friend

So now I must close for this time by  
bidding you good by and may God bless you  
and our heroes and rest our land once more  
to peace and your interest and care
