I find one Charles Kimball in
 Canaan who I am informed was
 in the hospital at Augusta last winter
 and his Sisters went down to see him
 and carried him some woman's clothes
 in which he dressed and escaped, He
 was not very communicative,
 but agreed to report himself to day
 or Saturday 30th. He said his
 Mother would come with him and try
 to get a discharge, Very respy Sir
