To the Governor of Maine

Dear Sir

In my own defense I write you a few lines hoping that my present situation will excuse me for doing so. Some five months since I was appointed Lieut of Co. D. and of course have been to some considerable expense both in living and equipments and as yet have not got any compensation I believe that I have been recommended by all of the highest Officers of the Regt and if you will have the goodness to consider my case you will greatly oblige your most humble servant
