Genl. I have the honor herewith to transmit to you a List of Killed & Wounded in the 1st Maine by ^{our} Artillery since May 15th. There was ^{one} made out soon after the Battle of the 19th of May. but as we have not seen any notice of it in the Papers, and no letters having been recd by our friends that were sent in the same mail I have come to the conclusion that the whole mail was lost and have had this prepared.
