Sir

Your letter of February 8th came duly to hand, and in answer would say that the number of recruits needed is three hundred (300), and through my recommendation Capt Sargent has been detailed by the commanding General to recruit in Maine for this Reg^t. I shall also have one other Captain detailed in a few days for the same purpose, and I hope you will aid them in the business—

As far as there is no vacancies for commissioned officers, should there be I will give you immediate notice.
